PANAMA Sometimes there are moments in our lives which stay with us, which leave us wondering...Did I make the right decision? Did it turn out ok?


Sometimes we are lucky to look into vibrant smiling eyes even years later, and we know it did.



A few years ago, in a small town in Panama, with one last large wheelchair on the truck, we met up with Alberto Salcedo who had lost both his legs after stepping on a live wire. This wheelchair was too large for him. We made phone calls; we made arrangements with our wonderful partners in Panama City, Club Activo 20-30, to bring him a better fitting one from this shipment later. The look in his eyes when

we took the chair with us again was heart-breaking, doubt overshadowing hope and trust.

Last month the same eyes caught mine during the try-outs for the Paralympic Games in wheelchair basketball. Beaming with recognition – and pride! Alberto had received his perfectly fitting wheelchair later and now leads an active life as the respected technical advisor to his team.
